

Working with the Neurobiological Legacy of Trauma

2010-11 Advanced Seminar Program

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Seminar format: we meet once a month for three hours, focusing at each session on a different topic related to the treatment of trauma and dissociation. We generally begin each meeting with a didactic presentation on the topic of the month, usually with much lively discussion and case vignettes, and then we apply the information to one or more cases that participants are willing to share with the group. The application of the concepts to a real case or cases helps to integrate the theoretical material.

Time: The seminar meets from 12pm-2pm one Wednesday per month and will run for nine months from September 2010 to May 2011.

Location: The seminar takes place at Dr. Fisher's offices at 23 Main Street in Watertown, Mass. Directions and parking information will be sent out the week before the start date of the seminar.

Continuing Education Credits: CEUs are available for the seminar for psychologists, social workers, and LMHCs for a small additional charge, and applications will be given out at the first meeting. If you elect to purchase CEUs, you will be credited regardless of which seminar you attend on a particular month as long as you are signed in.

Tuition: total tuition for the seminar is \$675, payable either at the first meeting, in 2-3 installments, or monthly (please let Dr. Fisher know if you wish to pay in installments). All students are responsible for full payment of the tuition by the end of the course. Payments may be made by check or with Visa or Master Card. If paying with a credit card, just download the credit card authorization form and fax it to 617-600-4594.

Registration: To register, just fill out the attached Interest Survey and return it to Dr. Fisher at the address below with a check for \$75 as a registration fee (to be credited against your total tuition). The Interest Survey helps Dr. Fisher to see the particular interests of participants and adjust the seminar content accordingly. Participants may also pay with Visa or MasterCard. To charge the registration fee or tuition payments, we will need the name on the account, billing address, card number, and expiration. Regardless of payment method, you can pay the remainder of the tuition in full, in 2-3 installments, or by the month. Just be aware that all participants are responsible for the full tuition amount, even if they choose to pay by the month.

Opportunity for case consultation: each month, time will be set aside for case consultation. In addition, group or individual consultation with Dr. Fisher is also available at an hourly rate.
